Thursday 27th September: Phantom Thread (15)

A bewitching film about secrets, obsession and elegance. Starring Daniel Day-Lewis and Lesley Manville as a renowned fashion designer and his sister. They have an elegant and ordered life at the social centre of 1950's London. Disruption comes in the form of the young strong willed Alma, his new muse and lover, threatening their carefully constructed lives. Described as 'a refined gothic love story', it looks gorgeous and captivates with some great performances.

Thursday 25th October: The Bromley Boys (PG)

A funny and touching story of a young fan's pursuit of Bromley FC, the worst football team in Britain at the time of his growing up in the 1960's. Based on a novel by Dave Roberts it is a heart-warming and comic tale of youth, passion, despair and obsession. Footy fans will love this film. And if you're not a fan there's plenty in it for you too.

Thursday 29th November: The Guernsey Literary and Potato Pie Society (12A)

Set in the aftermath of WW2 this is the delightful tale of a young London based writer who forms an unexpected bond with an odd band of residents on the island of Guernsey. Intriguing, multi layered and beautifully shot it weaves together a mystery, a war story and a love triangle into an uplifting and entertaining whole. Co starring Penelope Wilton. Directed by Mike Newell (Four Weddings and A Funeral) and starring Lily James.
